




We'd like to take this opportunity to wish all of our second grade families a very Happy Holiday Season!




For our next reading unit we are focusing on reading extensively about one nonfiction science topic. We will be reading closely to learn all we can about our topic. This reading unit goes hand in hand with our next writing unit which is writing an All-About book about our topic. We will be taking notes about what we read and discussing new information with our partners.



For our writing unit, we will be writing nonfiction books about the science topic we are reading about. We will be organizing our information in chapters.



In math we are studying measurement. The first unit is on using standard units of measurement (inches, feet, and yards) and equivalent measurements. Also the students need to know which unit of measure and which measuring tool is best for different objects measured. The next unit deals with measurement using the metric system (centimeters and meters). We will continue using equivalent measurements.



There are two math programs that your child should be using at home to continue working on the math skills they have been taught in school. One program is ThinkCentral and the other is Ten Marks.
