

## First Grade Goals - January 2017

### Reading Workshop

#### Readers Get to Know the Characters in Books

- Readers use pictures and words to learn important information about the characters in their books
- Readers reread books to make sure they don't miss important clues about their characters. They think about how the characters feel and act
- Readers think about how characters have changed and what lessons they have learned
- Readers cite evidence from the text to prove their ideas about their characters

### Writing Workshop

#### How-To-Books

- Writers learn the structure and craft of procedural writing, using words and pictures to teach others.
- Writers choose topics that are interesting and important to us.
- Writers dramatize and talk through our activities with partners.
- Writers plan and draft steps and directions that are clear and easy to follow.
- Writers revise and make our How-To texts even better.

#### All About Books

- Writers use what they know to teach others
- Writers organize their writing to show their ideas. They include leads and a have a sense of closure
- Writers supply facts and details to teach others

### Math

#### Addition and Subtraction Relationships

- Students will add and subtract within 20
- Students will work with addition and subtraction equations
- Students will use related facts to show the relationship between addition and subtraction
