

First Grade March 2017 Goals

Reading – Readers Can Be their Own Teachers, Working Hard to Figure out The Tricky Words and Parts in Books

- Readers remember to use all the strategies they know to solve new or tricky words. They always ask, does it look right? sound right? make sense?
- Readers make sure they always understand their books. They check for meaning as they read.
- Readers make sure they can read longer books and read them with fluency

Writing Workshop- Writing Reviews

- Writers state an opinion
- Writers organize their writing to show their ideas. They include leads and a have a sense of closure
- Writers supply reasons to support their opinion
- Writers use conventions in their writing- they capitalize names and places, use commas in dates and lists, and have capital and end punctuation in sentences

- Model and compare two-digit numbers to determine which is greater than or less than,
- Use symbols $<$, $>$, $=$ to compare numbers
- Solve problems using the strategy make a model
- Identify numbers ten more or ten less than a given number

Chapter 8 Two-digit Addition & Subtraction

- Add and subtract within 20
- Draw a model to add and subtract tens
- Use a hundred chart to find sums
- Make a ten to add a two-digit number and a one-digit number
- Use tens and ones to add two-digit numbers
- Solve and explain two-digit word problems
- Add and subtract within 100
