
For our next reading unit we are focusing on reading extensively about one nonfiction science topic. We will be reading closely to learn all we can about our topic. This reading unit goes hand in hand with our next writing unit which is writing an All-About book about our topic. We will be taking notes about what we read and discussing new information with our partners.



For our next writing unit, we will be writing nonfiction books about the science topic we are reading about. We will be organizing our information in chapters.



In math we are studying measurement. The first unit is on using standard units of measurement (inches, feet, and yards) and equivalent measurements. Also the students need to know which unit of measure and which measuring tool is best for different objects measured. The next unit deals with measurement using the metric system (centimeters and meters). We will continue using equivalent measurements.



There is an online program that your children are using in school called i-ready. On this program, your child can practice math and reading. They all have a user and password ID. Your children can also work on this program at home. Another program your child can use at home is RAZ-KIDS. On this website, your child has access to many leveled books.
