G.A.T.E. ENRICHMENT INTERACTIVE-FRAMEWORK for an engaging and differentiated Common Core:

Enrichment for G.A.T.E. classes involves hands-on projects in the S.T.E.A.M. spectrum, fostering critical thinking and allowing students to apply what they've learned. In our first unit on Art Appreciation, we'll be linking Art and Literacy, integrating and differentiating the Common Core State Standards for gifted and advanced learners.

G.A.T.E. classes will research, read and learn about the lives and works of art masters of the world (Pierre-Auguste Renoir, Claude Monet, Henri Matisse, Diego Rivera, N.C. Wyeth, W.S. Mount, Vincent van Gogh, Henri Rousseau) presented in engaging and informative depth, complexity and creativity. The skills of analyzing and comparing authentic informational texts will lay the groundwork for students to emulate and adapt different styles, in a variety of mediums, while using poetry to help convey personal feelings, emotions and ideas. By understanding the thinking and feeling processes of creative expression, we will focus on and encourage their development.
